

## Report for June 9, 2013 Butte HP match

I'd like to thank Jake Taverna for helping with range prep and to the crew who took the initiative and got the targets and flags up and range ready to go on Sunday morning - It is appreciated! Thanks.

The weather gods smiled on us for a brief time Sunday morning - I think everyone had an opportunity to shoot their standing and sitting rapid fire matches with little or no wind. The game changed at 300 yds! The wind came up and it only got stronger at 600 and for the VMR match. Stools, scopes and ammo were blown off the firing line more than once during the VMR.

### Just a quick recap:

In the Offhand match: Bob Evans took the lead and held on to it for the win with a 185-2X. In both Rapid fire matches Scott Lindley took the wins with 199-13X in SRF and 197-9X in PRF (including a 100-9X string in sitting and 100-7X in a PRF string). At 600 yds George Waldorf, shooting with his new Mk1 Mod 1 eyeballs, showed the youngsters how to do it. He shot a 190-5X for the win with a .223 AR match rifle. Lindley's consistent individual match scores earned him the Agg win with 765-31X

In the Master Class: Pat Hover placed 1st Master in Offhand, Prone Rapid Fire and Prone Slow fire and earned the class win with a 760-14X. Close behind was Steffen Bunde with a 753-15X

Expert Class: Scott Wehrmann won't be bothering the Experts much longer - he's headed to the Master class. He placed 1st Expert in all individual matches and totaled out with a 753-10X. As mentioned earlier, Bob Evans shook the Masters and High Masters up by winning the Offhand match. Good Shooting!

Sharpshooter/Marksman Class - Another shooter on his way up is Martin Bourque. Lee Maxey nipped him in the Offhand match and Chris Haynes had the class win in Prone Rapid but Martin held on to the Sitting rapid fire and 600 yd prone slow fire match. He took the class aggregate with 696-8X

Tactical Shooters - Charley Woolley pretty much had it his way in the Tactical class. Mike Vallee did sneak ahead in the 600 yds prone match. Woolley finished the Agg with 722-6X

### The Vintage Military Rifle Match:

I have to give a lot of credit to those who fired the VMR match -- the wind really came up during this match. Several times scopes, mats, shooting stools and ammo blew off of the firing line and had to be retrieved. There were some very good scores given the windy conditions. Lee Maxey had a 197 in the slow fire prone, fire., Jake Taverna had 94 in the prone rapid, Steffen Bunde had a 90 in the sitting rapid fire and Charley Woolley had an 87 in Offhand. I'm not sure how anyone hit much in offhand with the wind gusts! Thanks to Steffen Bunde for outfitting his sons Konrad and Warren and friend Doug Walsh for the match. Warren and Doug had a bit of trouble with Steffen's reloads and the no-alibi rule made it a bit tough on their scores. Konrad did well getting Doug through the course of fire. Being left-handed may have helped Doug. He could watch Konrad on the next firing point and mimic what he was doing to get ready. It seemed to work OK. Both Konrad and Doug are brand new 2LTs in the US Army's Big Green machine! Congratulations! George Waldorf and Dick Miller decided to give their M1 carbines a work out - maybe it wasn't the best day for the pistol sized .30 carbine load but they hung in there and did OK. Dick Miller remarked that maybe the Carbine wasn't the weapon that won the Pacific campaigns in WW2 after all.

Look ahead 2 weeks and we have Montana State Service Rifle Champs in Missoula at the Deep Cr range. On Friday: M1A/M-14 match; Saturday HP-XTC + 800 yd prone; Sunday a Team match and Rifle EIC, WOW!
